ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 2015

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR
ORDINANCE §153.544 TO ALLOW MORE TIME TO ADOPT, DENY
OR MODIFY A RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Section 153.544(A) requires the Council to adopt, deny or modify a recommendation of the Planning Commission within thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Oak Harbor has determined that thirty (30) days is not sufficient time procedurally to adopt, deny or modify a recommendation of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended amending §153.44(A) to allow sixty (60) days to adopt, deny or modify the Planning Commission recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Village of Oak Harbor is amending §153.544(A) to read as follows:

§154.33 ACTION BY VILLAGE COUNCIL.


(A) Within 60 days after the public hearing, the Village Council shall either adopt or deny the recommendation of the Planning Commission or adopt some modification thereof. In the event the Village Council denies or modifies the recommendation of the Planning Commission, it must do so by not less than three-fourths of the full membership of Village Council.

SECTION 2. The currently enacted version of §153.544(A) is hereby repealed in its entirety. The rest of §153.544 is not affected by this legislation.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and operation at the earliest date permitted by law.
