

ORDINANCE NO. 04- 2014

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD
CONTRACTS RELATING TO THE SECOND MILE (PHASE II) OF THE 163 WATER
LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor had its water lines examined and determined that the water line along State Route 163 is in a state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously replaced the first mile of the water line; and

WHEREAS, BEC Associates in the past provided the Village with specifications to replace the water line on State Route 163; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to have specifications prepared, advertise for bids and award contracts for the second mile (Phase II) of the 163 Water Line Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the above project is necessary to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the customers of the Oak Harbor water system and the citizens of Oak Harbor; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**


Section 1.

That the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ottawa County, Ohio, hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, advertise for bids for the second mile (Phase II) of the 163 Water Line Replacement Project and award contracts on the project to a lowest and/or best bidder and execute all documents necessary to accomplish the project.

Section 2.


