

**ORDINANCE NO. 05-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING PLANTATION LANE, OWNERSHIP OF THE WATER LINE, THE SANITARY SEWER LINE AND THE ELECTRIC LINE AND THE FRONT LOT STORM SEWERS CONTAINED IN THE EASEMENT AREA GRANTED TO THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR BY GORDON LUMBER COMPANY, AND ACCEPTANCE OF OBLIGATION TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN SAME AS A PUBLIC UTILITY**

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2005, Oak Harbor Planning Commission approved the final plat for the Plantation Subdivision, which included the construction of Plantation Lane, a water line, sanitary sewer line, electric line and the front lot storm sewers; and

**WHEREAS**, said construction is complete and inspected as contained in the final approved plat and Council now desires to accept the street and the utilities and the obligation to operate and maintain same as public utilities; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**Section 1.**

That Plantation Lane, and the water line, sanitary sewer line, electric line and the front lot storm sewers contained in the easement area of Plantation Lane are accepted by the Village of Oak Harbor and are hereby dedicated for public use, operation and maintenance as a public utility of the Village of Oak Harbor.

**Section 2.**

This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

**Section 3.**


That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
