

ORDINANCE NO. 07- 2014

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACT
RELATING TO GARBAGE AND CURBSIDE RECYCLING
AND DECLARING EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Oak Harbor has determined that it is necessary to have a comprehensive collection system of garbage so there will be a weekly removal from the curb or alley and for final disposal of all garbage and recyclable material, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids and award contract for Garbage and Curbside Recycling; and said action is hereby determined to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village, and as such, shall be effective immediately, upon due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer because the bid specifications need to be advertised immediately to allow sufficient time to review the bids and award the contract before the current contract expires;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Garbage and Curbside Recycling Contract is necessary to protect the property of the residents and to provide for a weekly removal from the curb or alley and for final disposal of all garbage and recyclable material is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids and award contract for Garbage and Curbside Recycling.

Section 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4. For the reason stated in the preamble herein and because the contract with the Village to collect rubbish and recyclables expires, and the bids must be submitted immediately to enter into a new contract, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and as such, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.
