**ORDINANCE NO. 08-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY  
REQUIREMENT FOR THE CURRENT VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR**

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the appointment of Village Administrator for a Village; and

WHEREAS, that Section provides that the Village Administrator shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his appointment by the Mayor and confirmation by the legislative authority, unless said requirement is waived by ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to waive the residency requirement for the current Village Administrator;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1.

That the residency requirement set forth in Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code is hereby waived for the current Village Administrator, and the current Village Administrator only. The current Village Administrator, Randy Genzman, does not have to reside within the Village of Oak Harbor.

Section 2.

This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.
