

ORDINANCE NO. 12- 2014

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §76.10 OF THE
VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR ORDINANCES AND ADDING
PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR WALNUT STREET**

WHEREAS, the traffic in the vicinity of the Oak Harbor Middle School has increased;
and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to regulate the parking around the Middle School to increase the safety and facilitate the traffic flow; and

WHEREAS, the number of children at R.C. Waters has increased, therefore, the traffic around the school has increased; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that limiting the parking on Walnut Street between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on days school is in session will increase safety and facilitate traffic flow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1.

That §76.10(A) of the Village of Oak Harbor Ordinances be amended to read:

“(A)(1) Parking of motor vehicles is hereby prohibited along the south side of Ottawa Street running from Locust Street east to Maple Street and no parking on Maple Street from Water Street to Main Street in the Village from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Mondays through Fridays during the school year of the Benton-Carroll-Salem Local School District. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon the paved or main traveled part of Ottawa Street as enumerated in this division and during the times and hours as prohibited in this division.

(A)(2) Parking of motor vehicles is hereby prohibited along the south side of Walnut Street between Church Street and Locust Street in the Village from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday during the school year of the Benton-Carroll-Salem Local School District.”

The remaining sections of 76.10 shall remain in full force and effect as written.

Section 2.


