

**ORDINANCE NO. 18-2014**

**ORDINANCE REPEALING VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR ORDINANCE §93.27(F)  
AND REPLACING §93.27(F) REGARDING  
NEWSPAPERS AND SIMILAR ITEMS AS LITTER**

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Harbor enacted an Ordinance prohibiting the discarding of litter; and

WHEREAS, in that Ordinance, there is a prohibition against certain acts regarding the placement of newspapers, advertising material, handbills, and other similar items; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to modify the Ordinance regarding that section.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That §93.27(F) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Oak Harbor is hereby repealed. All other subsections of that Ordinance are to remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 2.** That §93.27(F) shall now be replaced as follows:

(F) No person shall deliver, distribute or otherwise place newspapers, advertising material, flyers, handbills or other like material in the village on streets, sidewalks, parks, lawns and the like, unless the same are placed in a receptacle furnished by the recipient for that purpose, firmly secured to a door knob or door handle, or placed between a door and screen door or storm door.


**SECTION 3.** This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
