

ORDINANCE NO. 19-2014

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR ORDINANCE
§38.14 REGARDING INCOME TAX CREDIT
PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY**

WHEREAS, currently the Village gives a credit for its residents who pay income tax to a different municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined it needs to raise revenue to allow it to provide the services to the Village residents and guests it currently provides; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to discontinue the credit given to taxes paid to other municipalities as set forth in the current Village Ordinance §38.14;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1.

The Village of Oak Harbor Ordinance §38.14 is hereby repealed in its entirety and the tax credit given for taxes paid to another municipality is withdrawn.

Section 3.

This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

Section 4.


That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
