

ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 2016

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE OTTAWA SANDUSKY SENECA JOINT
SOLID WASTE DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Ottawa Sandusky Seneca Joint Solid Waste District provides funding to municipalities in its jurisdiction for certain projects; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Harbor intends to apply for funding from the Ottawa Sandusky Seneca Joint Solid Waste District for eligible projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1.

That the Village Administrator of the Village of Oak Harbor is hereby authorized and directed to apply for funding from the Ottawa Sandusky Seneca Joint Solid Waste District and to sign all documents for application for said funding.


Section 2.

This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Oak Harbor for the reasons that the application for funding must be submitted to the Ottawa Sandusky Seneca Joint Solid Waste District immediately and therefore three (3) readings are not possible. As such, this Ordinance shall take effect and of full force immediately upon due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.

Section 3.


