

ORDINANCE 03-2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD A CONTRACT RELATED TO THE 2016 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Harbor has examined the transportation infrastructure in the Village; and

WHEREAS, certain streets, roads and alleys are in need of replacement or repair and need immediate attention; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received notice from the Ohio Public Works Commission of an awarded grant in the amount of \$175,000 for the resurfacing of East Main Street and Benton Street; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to have specifications prepared, advertise for bids and award a contract for the 2016 Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the above project is necessary to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens and businesses of Oak Harbor.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be and hereby is directed to enter into a contract with Poggemeyer Design Group to engineer, prepare specifications and to advertise for bids and award contract to the lowest and/or best bidder.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning this and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.


Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect and after the earliest date allowed by law.
