ORDINANCE 6 - 2017

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD
A CONTRACT RELATED TO THE 2017 STREET MAINTENANCE PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Harbor, in accordance with its 2017 Street Maintenance Program, has examined the transportation infrastructure in the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the examination, certain streets, roads and alleys are in need of replacement or repair and need immediate attention; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to have specifications prepared, advertise for bids and award a contract to replace or repair any transportation infrastructure needed for the 2017 Street Maintenance Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the above project is necessary to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens and businesses of Oak Harbor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be and hereby is directed to enter into a contract with Poggemeyer Design Group to engineer, prepare specifications for any replacement or repairs needed, to advertise for bids and award a contract to the lowest and/or best bidder and to execute any and all documents necessary to accomplish the award of the contract.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of council concerning this and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.



That this Ordinance authorizing the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, advertise for bids and award a contract related to the 2017 Street Maintenance Project is an emergency measure, for the reason that in order for the replacement or repairs to be completed in the 2017 construction season, action must be started immediately.
