ORDINANCE NO. 06 - 2019

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT
FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL OFFICER

WHEREAS, Section 735.262 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the appointment of Fiscal Officer for a Village; and

WHEREAS, that Section provides that the Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his/her appointment by the Mayor and confirmation by the legislative authority, unless said requirement is waived by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to waive the residency requirement for the current fiscal officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the residency requirement set forth in Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code is hereby waived for the current fiscal officer and the current fiscal officer only. The current Fiscal Officer, Amy E. Drummer, does not have to reside within the Village of Oak Harbor.

Section 2. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
