ORDINANCE NO. 8, 2018

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACTS RELATING TO CHURCH STREET REPAVING FROM WATER STREET TO SOUTH RAILROAD STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor has examined the roads in the Village and determined Church Street from Water Street to South Railroad Street is in disrepair; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined that the above-mentioned section of Church Street needs repaved; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to authorize the Village Administrator to have specifications prepared, advertise for bids and award contracts for the Church Street repaving project between Water Street and South Railroad Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has determined that the above project is necessary to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Oak Harbor; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**Section 1.**

That the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ottawa County, Ohio, hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, advertise for bids for the Church Street Repaving Project between Water Street and South Railroad Street and award contracts on the project to a lowest and/or best bidder and execute all documents necessary to accomplish the project.


**Section 2.**

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were taken in meetings of Council, open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3.

That this Ordinance authorizing the Village Administrator to prepare specifications and to advertise for bids and award contract to the lowest and/or best bidder is an emergency measure because the project needs to be completed before school begins to avoid hazardous traffic/pedestrian conditions.
