ORDINANCE NO. 10 - 2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BENTON-CARROLL-SALEM SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Harbor is located within the Benton-Carroll-Salem (BCS) School District; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to work with BCS to provide a School Resource Officer (SRO) to provide for the safety of the students and staff of BCS and the citizens, residents and visitors of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1.

The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with BCS to provide a SRO. The agreement has been reviewed and approved by Village Council and the Police Chief.


Section 2.

This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

Section 3.

That this Ordinance authorizing the Village Administration to enter into an agreement with BCS to provide a SRO is an emergency measure, for the reason that a SRO needs to be hired immediately in order to be available for the beginning of the school year.
