

ORDINANCE NO. 12-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 02-2017 TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2017, Council of the Village of Oak Harbor adopted as an emergency measure, Ordinance No. 02-2017, entitled An Ordinance to Make Appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures Of The Village of Oak Harbor, State of Ohio, During the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2017 and Declaring an Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer has advised Council that it is necessary to amend the appropriation due to additional moneys needed for the Police Department because of payouts caused by the retirement of two employees, the small increase in Police wages and some additional benefits increases; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 02-2017, and said action is hereby determined to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village because the amendment is necessary to meet the Police Department payroll, and as such, shall be effective immediately, upon due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 02-2017 entitled An Ordinance to Make Appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures Of The Village Of Oak Harbor, State of Ohio, During Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2017 and Declaring an Emergency hereby is amended as follows:

Amended Appropriations:

General Fund


Police Law Enforcement:

Section 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. For the reasons stated in the preamble herein, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, and as such, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.
