ORDINANCE NO. 13 - 2015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR ORDINANCE NO. 6-2013 TO ADD THE UTILITY CLERK POSITIONS TO THE WAGE ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council passed Ordinance No. 6-2013 establishing the wages for the various positions and jobs performed by Village employees; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has established new positions for the Village in the Utility Collection Department; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council now needs to establish a wage range for the newly created positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1.

Ordinance No. 6-2013, Section 1, Exhibit A, is hereby amended to add:

- Pay Range 1 – Utility Billing Supervisor
- Pay Range 2 – Billing Clerk
- Pay Range 2 – Part-Time Billing Clerk

Section 3.

All other sections of Ordinance No. 6-2013 shall not be affected by this Ordinance.


Section 4.
